#### NEW: Highly Affected Sectors Credit Availability Program (HASCAP)



**What:** Loans between \$25,000 and \$1 million to cover operational cash flow needs. The loans feature a 4% interest rate, a repayment term of up to 10 years, and up to a 12 month postponement of principal payments.

**Who:** Small & medium-sized businesses that have seen their revenues decrease by 50% or more due to COVID-19.

Application Deadline: June 30, 2021

## **UPDATED:** Canada Emergency Rent Subsidy (CERS)



**What:** Commercial rent or property expenses (property taxes, property insurance and insurance on commercial mortgages) support of up to 65%. NEW: Proposed program extension until June 5, 2021.

**Who:** Qualifying businesses affected by COVID-19 can apply directly. Landlord participation is not required.

#### **UPDATED: CERS Lockdown Support**



**What:** Additional commercial rent or property expenses of 25%. NEW: Proposed program extension until June 5, 2021.

**Who:** Businesses significantly affected by a public health order for a week or more.

# **UPDATED:** Canada Emergency Business Account (CEBA)



**What:** Interest-free loans of up to \$60,000, of which a total of \$20,000 will be forgiven if the balance of the loan is repaid by December 31, 2022.

**Who:** Small businesses who have seen a drop in revenue due to COVID-19. NEW: Applicants can now use a personal banking account.

Application Deadline: June 30, 2021

# **UPDATED:** Canada Emergency Wage Subsidy (CEWS)



**What:** Subsidy of up to 75% of an employee's wages for qualifying eligible employers to keep and re-hire employees and avoid layoffs. NEW: Proposed program extension until June 5, 2021.

**Who:** Businesses who have seen a drop in revenue due to COVID-19.

# **UPDATED:** Regional Relief & Recovery Fund (RRRF)



**What:** Help for businesses unable to access other support measures—25% of overall funding reserved for tourism sector

**Who:** Businesses that have applied for federal relief measures and have not been able to secure funds; or accessed COVID-19 relief measures and continue to experience hardship.

# **EDC Business Credit Availability Program (BCAP) Guarantee**



**What:** New operating lines of credit or new term loans support cash flow needs for small & medium-sized enterprises

**Who:** Exporting & non-exporting businesses impacted by COVID-19 who were financially viable prior to the current economic situation

#### **Black Entrepreneurship Fund**



**What:** Loans of up to \$250,000 through the Black Entrepreneurship Loan Fund

**Who:** Black business owners and entrepreneurs

**Note:** The Loan Fund will start accepting applications in May 2021.

### **Support For Indigenous Businesses**



**What:** Interest-free loans up to \$40,000 and a non-repayable contribution up to \$20,000

**Who:** Small & medium Indigenous businesses that are current or former clients of an Aboriginal Financial Institution

#### **Canada Recovery Benefit (CRB)**



What: Income support of \$500 per week for up to 38 weeks

**Who:** Income support for employed or selfemployed individuals who are not eligible for Employment Insurance (EI)

Deadline: September 25, 2021

### **COVID-19 Work-Sharing Program**



**What:** Help for employers and employees to avoid layoffs when there is a temporary decrease in business activity beyond the control of the employer

**Who:** Year-round businesses in operation for at least one year

Deadline: NEW: September 26, 2021

#### **Small Business Loan Guarantee Program**



What: Term loans, working capital and lines of credit up to \$500,000

**Who:** All businesses except residential and commercial real estate, beverage rooms and taverns

#### Small Business Real Property Tax Rebate Program



**What:** A one-time rebate of \$1,000 or 50% of property taxes paid for the last 6 months of the 2020-21 tax year

**Who:** Dine-in restaurants & drinking establishments, gyms and fitness establishments, and personal service businesses like salons, spas and body art establishments

## Tourism Accommodations Real Property Tax Rebate Program – Part 2



**What:** A one-time 50% rebate on the first 6 months of their commercial property taxes paid for 2021-2022.

**Who:** Eligible tourism accommodation operators. Operators that received a rebate through Part 1 of the program are automatically eligible for Part 2. These businesses will be contacted directly.
