Less is More!!!

You may have heard this old adaget is true! Declutter: Only have what people need. Example of Grandad's Cottage What do people need?







Less is More: Bedrooms & Bathrooms

Think of a hotel when it comes to bedrooms, and bathrooms. I suggest white linens- easy to clean and replace Extra Throws Fans, if place gets stuffy from time to time 4 pillows/ bed (min.)

You do not need to supply products aside from hand soap, toilet paper, paper towel, a couple of cleaning products

Toiletries would be an added value item & need to be done well.



Less is More: Kitchen

Minimal spices

Cooking utensils, a set of cutlery, cutting boards, glasses, mugs, dinnerware (how much?)

A SET of pots and pans, Coffee Pot, Kettle

Leave fridge bare

Nice to have a few added value pieces in the kitchen (coffee can be instant, teas, sugar packs, creamer)

A table that fits the space, the amount of chairs of max. occupancy

If this does not apply to you- where can they eat locally? What is your menu? The menu of nearby restaurants? Healthy options, Dietary restrictions



Less is more: Living Area

Comfortable Seating , not too much. Consider the amount of people staying. Do not clutter like Grandad's cottage. Optional Pull Out Sofa, can increase your nightly rate Throw Blankets Cushions

In the pandemic, Hispeed Wifi and a Desk area has become more important (if possible)

Added Value: booklets on table, info centre



It's time to freshen up!

After you 've declutttered, it 's time to freshen up...And you can do it on a shoestring!

Paint goes a LOOOOONG way!

Update Hardware

Furniture - does anything need replacing? le. mattresses vs whole bed or maybe just bedding!
